SCIENTIFIC COOPERATION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
THE ACCADÉMIA NAZIONALE DEI LINCEI
AND
THE AUSTRALIAN ACADEMY OF THE HUMANITIES

Article 1

The Australian Academy of the Humanities and the Accademia Nazionale dei Lincei agree to encourage scientific cooperation between Italian and Australian scientists and scholars. In the specific intent of this cooperation, the Parties will promote scientific exchanges, visits, research in collaboration, conferences and meetings, exchanges of publications and information. Both Academies will promote contacts between the scientific institutes in Australia and Italy in order to establish projects of collaboration.

Article 2

The two Academies propose to seek ways to set up the exchange of young scientists on a reciprocal basis. This exchange will be regulated as follows: the host Academy will bear the costs of the scholars' accommodation and travel within its country while the cost of travel between one country and the other will be borne by the sending Academy.

Article 3

The missions and grants will be devoted to various activities: research in scientific laboratories, libraries and cultural centres, visits to cultural and scientific institutes of the host country, lessons, seminars, promotion of debates on arguments of common interest, participation in work reunions and possible scientific congresses.

Article 4

The exchanges will, on a case by case basis, be proposed by one of the two Academies and must be approved by the other Academy.

Article 5.


The two Academies will draw up a detailed executive protocol, to be re-examined every three years if necessary, to establish the modalities, the duration, the amounts and anything else necessary to render active the exchanges of scholars and grant holders.

Article 6

The present agreement is signed by the two Parties in Rome, on 8 June 2011. It will remain valid until one of the Parties notifies the other of its intention to interrupt it; the request for annulment must be made with at least one year's notice. Any outstanding activities should be brought to an end in a manner satisfactory to both Parties.



EXECUTIVE PROTOCOL
OF THE SCIENTIFIC COOPERATION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE ACCADÉMIA NAZIONALE DEI LINCEI
AND THE AUSTRALIAN ACADEMY OF THE HUMANITIES

Pursuant to Article 5 of the Scientific Cooperation Agreement between the Australian Academy of the Humanities and the Accademia Nazionale dei Lincei and for the purpose of implementing Article 2, both Academies agree as follows:

I - TERMS OF EXCHANGE

1. The Australian Academy of the Humanities and the Accademia Nazionale dei Lincei shall exchange young scholars according to the following annual quota: one research periods of one month each per year.
2. The above mentioned period, i.e. one month in 2011, one month in 2012 and one month in 2013, should be used by the end of each calendar year. If, in the course of a calendar year, either of the two Academies is unable to avail itself for any reason whatsoever of the period of exchange such period cannot be postponed, nor added to a subsequent year.

II - PROCEDURE FOR THE DESIGNATION OF CANDIDATES

1. Eligible candidates shall be designated no later than three months before the proposed arrival in the host country.
2. The sending Academy shall supply the other Party with the following details concerning the nominees: forename, surname, date and place of birth, university degree, short scientific biography, field of specialization, present appointment, degree of knowledge of foreign languages, proposed dates of arrival and departure and outline

programme of scientific work in the host country. Letters of acceptance from the host centres proposed by the candidate must be attached to the application.

3. The receiving Academy shall inform the other Party within six weeks after the receipt of the designation whether the visit can be included in the framework of the exchange programme.

4. The sending Academy shall notify the other Party of the visitor's arrival at least fourteen days in advance.

5. At the end of the study period the scholar must present to both Academies a report of his/her research.

III - FINANCIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The sending Academy shall bear the travelling expenses of its own candidates to and from the host country.

2. The receiving Academy shall pay an all-inclusive allowance to each visiting scholar of: Euro 1,500 in Italy; Australian Dollars 2,000 in Australia.


IV - GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. This Executive Protocol is signed by the two Parties in Rome, on 8 June 2011 and shall remain in full force and effect for a term of three years beginning 1 January 2012.

2. The Accademia Nazionale dei Lincei and the Australian Academy of the Humanities hereby agree that they shall meet at the end of the three year period in order to review the implementation of the cooperation. Otherwise the present Protocol is to be considered tacitly renewed on a yearly basis.
