**CONTRACT**

between the Italian Embassy in Canberra (hereinafter called the “Embassy of Italy” and GLG (hereinafter referred to as “Green Life Group”), agreed the following terms:

- 1) The Embassy of Italy in Canberra (hereinafter referred to as “the Embassy”) hereby accepts the quotation dated 19/12/2016 submitted by GLG (hereinafter referred to as “Green Life Group”) for the annual maintenance (20 services a year) of the park and grounds at the Italian Embassy in Canberra compound for the total amount of AUD\$ 13,978.62 (thirteen thousand nine hundred seventy eight dollars and sixty two cents only), GST included.
- 2) The present agreement is for the complete garden maintenance to perform the following tasks as necessary: lawn maintenance (mowing and edging, nature strip), pruning, trimming (including hedges) and weeding, spraying (to control growth in certain areas), blow down concrete areas and roadways.
- 3) The contract will start on January, 1<sup>st</sup> 2017 and will terminate on December, 31 2017.
- 4) GLG Green Life Group will be liable for personal injury or property damage either belonging to the Embassy or to third parties which may occur as a result of negligence by its part. GLG Greenlife Group hereby further agrees to provide the Embassy with a copy of its Public Liability and Workers Compensation insurance policies valid for the duration of the contract (1<sup>st</sup> January – 31 December, 2017). It is agreed that this is only a service contract and that the Company GLG assumes all compensation and insurance benefit payments referred to the works considered in the contract.
- 5) For security purposes, the employees of GLG will perform their duties during normal office hours. The services carried out by GLG cannot be subcontracted. The work will comprise 20 (twenty) services a year as mutually agreed between the parties, as it needed. It is also agreed that GLG’s personnel must report upon their visits at the Embassy by signing the register at the entrance of the Chancery. If for some reason GLG misses one of the services agreed upon, GLG (Green Life Group) will not charge the Italian Embassy for the hours not worked.

- 6) Throughout the execution of the work in question the Company must respect the agreement established herein and conform to the Italian regulations, as much as they are compatible with the current Australian legislation and regulations. Should the Company fail to observe the conditions and agreements here established or the aforesaid standard and norms this Embassy of Italy can arrange otherwise for the completion of the work at the Company's sole risk and rescind its obligation by means of a simple statement to that effect.
- 7) The Embassy avails itself right, at its unquestionable discretion, to terminate this agreement in the event of misconduct of the Company or failure to perform the services agreed upon, and submit claims for damages against the Company, which will be held responsible for supplementary expenses incurred by the Embassy for the completion of services.
- 8) This contract may be terminated at the unquestionable discretion by either party by first giving one month's notice in writing.
- 9) In the execution of the services that forms the object of this contract the Company assumes the complete responsibility for any damages or injury to Embassy personnel or property as well as third parties, including the people employed directly or indirectly by the Company, caused by failure or neglect in the execution of the said services.
- 10) Payment will be made monthly upon the receipt of regular invoices, upon the approval of the services rendered in a trades like manner.



