From **23 to 29 November 2020**, the Embassy of Italy will host the fifth edition of the "Week of the Extraordinary Italian Taste", an initiative of Italy's Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation aimed at celebrating and promoting the tradition and culture of **Italian cuisine**.

The theme of the Week will be: **Sapere e Sapori** (knowledge and tastes) **of the Italian territory**, with a particular focus on the relationship between Italian agricultural products and the land they come from.

Some events upon invitation will explore the following topics:

- 1) The importance of a **healthy lifestyle** as a combination of physical activity and wholesome diet: benefits of the **Mediterranean diet**.
- 2) **Food in Space**: where knowledge and taste join together. Italian companies and scientists are working together to produce sustainable and tasty food. Two **astronauts** will share their personal experience.
- 3) How **geographical indications** add value to their territory and how they can benefit **regional tourism**.
- 4) **Sapere e Sapori** at the **movies**: screening of **Quanto basta**.
