## Call for **Premio Italia 2023** **National Prize for University Students of Italian**

The Embassy of Italy in Canberra sends a call to all university students studying Italian for the best essay, short story or comic strips, of no more than 1,500 words, written in Italian. The competition is open to students enrolled in a program leading to an undergraduate or a graduate degree, and undertaking a course in the Italian Program of an Australian University.

The theme of this year is:

### **L'ITALIANO E LA SOSTENIBILITÀ**

The Prize is a voucher (AUD 2,000.00) to purchase a RETURN FLIGHT TICKET TO ITALY offered by the Italian Cultural Institute in Melbourne (\* conditions apply). The Prize will be announced on 21<sup>st</sup> October 2023, during the Conference for Teachers of Italian, organized in Brisbane.

The works must be submitted to the relevant department of participating universities. The university will send a copy of the written essays, short story or comic strips with a brief presentation of the authors - no more than 200 words - via e-mail, to the same address [Bruna.Carboni@anu.edu.au](mailto:Bruna.Carboni@anu.edu.au) with PREMIO ITALIA as subject, by **30/09/2023**.
