Australian National Prize for University Students of Italian

Call for Essays, Short Stories or Comic Strips

The Embassy of Italy in Canberra is delighted to announce Premio Italia 2024 and invites all university students of Italian to submit an essay, short story or comic strip, written in Italian and not exceeding 1,500 words, for evaluation.

The competition is open to students enrolled in a program leading to an undergraduate or graduate degree, and undertaking at the time of submission a course in the Italian Program at an Australian University.

This year's theme is: **L'ITALIANO E IL LIBRO: IL MONDO FRA LE RIGHE**

Prize

The Prize is a voucher (AUD 2,000.00) toward the purchase a RETURN FLIGHT TICKET TO ITALY offered by the Italian Cultural Institute of Sydney (*conditions apply). The Prize will be announced on 19th October 2024, during the National Conference for Teachers of Italian in Melbourne.

Submission

All works must be submitted through the Department of Italian Studies of participating universities, which are invited to indicate their interest in the Premio Italia initiative by 30/08/2024, by e-mailing Bruna.Carboni@anu.edu.au with PREMIO ITALIA in the subject line.

The convenor must then send a copy of the submitted works, with a brief presentation of the authors – no more than 200 words – via e-mail, to the same address Bruna.Carboni@anu.edu.au with PREMIO ITALIA in the subject line, by **30/09/2024**.
